


## SIMPLE (INDEFINITE)

## **PROGRESSIVE** (CONTINUOUS)

am/is/are

+ verb + ing

at this moment at present tonight Look!.. Listen!..

when

while



I am playing football now.

I am waiting for the train to arrive.

## PERFECT

## have/has + ed/V3



just, already for 3 hours/since since early morning since 3 o'clock ever, never yet, not yet this week (month, year), today lately, recently

# have/has been

+ verb + ing

for (5 minutes) How Iona ...?

for two hours

the whole day/week

all day/year



I have been playing football for two hours.

We have been waiting here for 3 hours.

verb + ed/V2

yesterday last week/year five minute ago long time ago

+ verb + ing

had + ed/V3

hardly..when scarcely..when no sooner..than

had been + verb + ing for two hours all day/year the whole day/week

for (5 minutes) How long ...?


The grass was wet because it had been raining all night long.

tomorrow soon next week/next year in a week



from 3 till 5 o'clock tomorrow this time next week this time tomorrow at 3 p.m. tomorrow tonight for two hours



I will have played football

by 3 o'clock tomorrow.


I will have finished my work

by tomorrow evening.

by 3 o'clock will have tomorrow + ed/V3 by ... week

by ... month by ... year by ... decade

by the end of the day + verb + ing for two hours by the time all day long for (5 minutes) the last couple of hours



will have been

I will have been playing football for two hours by the time more players arrived.

> By the time she graduates I will have been teaching English for two years.

I will play football tomorrow.

We will call you on the weekend.

I will be playing football from 3 till 5 o'clock tomorrow.

I will be doing my homework between 6:00 and 7:00 p.m. tomorrow night.
